JET AVIATION, SINGAPORE GROUND BREAKING CEREMONY LAUNCHES NEW HANGAR PROJECT WITH AIRCRAFT SUPPORT INDUSTRIES (ASI)

On October 21st 2016, Jet Aviation held a Ground Breaking Ceremony to launch its third new Hangar project and Ancillary works that was awarded to Aircraft Support Industries in September 2016. The project will add 3,850 square meters of Hangar space, 315 square meters of storage space and 380 square meters to the Interior Shop as well as additional space for equipment to be constructed at the Seletar Airport in Singapore.

Jet Aviation Group President Rob Smith added, "This expansion project has been fully supported by EDB and JTC for which we are very grateful". The Singapore Facility will have a total hangar space of 11,650 square meters, with Hangar three equipped to accommodate an additional two Boeing Business Jet (BBJ) aircraft or five Gulfstream G550 aircraft.

The project is due for completion in November 2017.
